Rules & Regulations

- a) Mitchell Fair Rules & Regulations apply.
- b) All work must be the work of the exhibitor, except where stated.
- c) Attach entry tags with safety pins, NO straight pins, needles or staples.
- d) All articles must be new, not used or soiled, and not have moth ball or other odors.
- e) All articles can only be exhibited once at the Mitchell Fair.
- f) Remember - please use the theme as often as you can.
- g) All personal names on quilts must be covered.
- h) Entry tags MUST BE signed

Point System for Judging Hand Quilts:

55 Points – Workmanship
25 Points – General appearance & design
20 Points – Colour Material

Point System for Judging Machine Quilting:

70 Points – Workmanship of Quilt
15 Points – Overall appearance
15 Points – Suitability of machine quilting.

O.A.A.S. ANNUAL CHAMPIONSHIP

QUILT COMPETITIONS

ELIGIBILITY, RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A. **HAND and MACHINE** quilts must have a total perimeter measurement of **324" minimum**, square or rectangular. (smaller quilts do not qualify).
- B. **HAND and MACHINE** quilts must be solely made by the Exhibitor, exhibited and judged at a local fair to be eligible for this competition.
- C. Judging will occur at local fairs and District Competition held October this year. A Provincial Grand Champion Quilt will be selected at the Annual O.A.A.S. Convention, Toronto in February next year.
- D. Upon making an entry in the OAAS Quilt Competition, the Exhibitor, by saying **YES** on their entry tag, agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition.
- E. The winning O.A.A.S. Quilt **will not** be eligible to compete in any future District and/or Convention O.A.A.S. competition.
- F. Winner's name to be displayed at the Fair on a sign provided by O.A.A. S.

LOCAL FAIR COMPETITION:

- A. Each local Fair is entitled to send only the GRAND CHAMPION QUILT to the District Competition. If any entry wins Grand Champion at more than one Fair, the other Fairs at which this quilt won, may enter their Reserve Champion quilt in the District Competition.
- B. An exhibitor who wins more than one Best of Show title with a different quilt at different Fairs shall be entitled to enter each winning quilt to compete at the District Competition.
- C. Local Homecraft Divisions are requested to judge a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion quilt from all first and second prize Quilts in all the sections.

***NOTE:** If an Exhibitor wins Grand Champion at other than his/her own Fair, or at more than one Fair, the Exhibitor must consider the Agricultural Society nearest his/her home address as the one from which will be sent to the District meeting.*
