- d) In order to qualify for prize money, the competitors must have a minimum of 5 acres
- of corn, soybeans or wheat, and must show from this field 4 litres of cleaned fall
- wheat, 6 cobs of grain corn, 6 plants of soybeans, or 6 stalks of silage corn.
- e) Final score based on 75% field score plus 25% exhibit at fair. Ties are broken by field score.
- f) Entry date for Wheat ~ July 5


